

# Descendants of John Wood Sandidge

---

## First Generation

1. **John Wood Sandidge** (son of John S. Sandidge and Mary Wood) was born on 29 Jul 1809 in Albemarle Co., VA. He died on 14 Jun 1857 in Saline Co., MO. He was a farmer. A newspaper death notice called him Captain John Sandidge, but it is not known whether he was ever actually in the military.

He was married to Maria Louisa Brents on 15 Jul 1834 in Green Co., KY. **Maria Louisa Brents** (daughter of Joshua Brents and Rebecca Allen Worley) was born on 16 Jul 1816, probably in Green Co., KY. She died on 8 Jan 1906 in Saline Co., MO, and was buried in Ridge Park Cemetery, Marshall, MO. Maria was widowed three times. Ten years after John's death, she married Samuel or B.F. Whitsett on 5 Dec 1867 in Saline Co., MO; then she married James Isbell on 18 Oct 1870, also in Saline Co., MO. She had no children from her other marriages. John Wood Sandidge and Maria Louisa Brents had the following children:

- +2 i. **Micajah Carr Sandidge** (born on 13 May 1835).
- 3 ii. **Josephine E. Sandidge** was born about 1837 in KY. She died before Jul 1857 (based on not being listed as an heir in her father's probate case file).
- +4 iii. **Maria Louisa Sandidge** (born on 30 Sep 1841).
- +5 iv. **Rebecca E. (Ella) Sandidge** (born in May 1844).
- +6 v. **Presley S. Sandidge** (born about 1848).
- 7 vi. **John S. Sandidge** was born about 1849, probably in Saline Co., MO. He died after 1908 (he received a share of his mother's estate in Mar 1908). He was a farmer.
- +8 vii. **Mary Wood (Mollie) Sandidge** (born on 12 Sep 1850).
- 9 viii. **Joshua B. Sandidge** was born about 1853, probably in Saline Co., MO. He died before May 1897 (based on not being mentioned in his mother's will).
- 10 ix. **William P. Sandidge** was born about 1854, probably in Saline Co., MO. He died before May 1897 (based on not being mentioned in his mother's will).
- 11 x. **Henrietta G. Sandidge** was born on 16 Oct 1855, probably in Saline Co., MO. She died on 11 Oct 1860.

## Second Generation

2. **Micajah Carr Sandidge** (John Wood-1) was born on 13 May 1835 in Hart Co., KY. He died on 30 Apr 1891 in Saline Co., MO. (There is some uncertainty about his birth date.) He was buried in Ridge Park Cemetery, Marshall, MO. He served in the military in the Civil War (Confederate). In May 1864 he was sent into the Federal lines as a spy and was taken prisoner. He was a farmer when he was young, and then was the elected county recorder of Saline Co., MO, for many years.

He was married to his first cousin, Elizabeth A. Mayfield, on 5 Dec 1869 in Saline Co., MO. **Elizabeth A. Mayfield** (daughter of Thomas Mayfield and Ellen Douglass Brents, who was a sister of Maria Louisa Brents) was born on 12 May 1850, probably in Hart Co., KY. She died on 27 Jan 1875 in Saline Co., MO, and was buried in Mt. Olive Cemetery, Saline Co., MO. Micajah Carr Sandidge and Elizabeth A. Mayfield had the following children:

- 12 i. **John Thomas Sandidge** was born about 1871 in MO. He died after 1908 (he received a share of his grandmother's estate in Mar 1908).
- 13 ii. **Elizabeth A. (Minnie) Sandidge** was born about 1872 in MO. She died about 1894.
- +14 iii. **Micajah Carr (Mike) Sandidge Jr.** (born on 27 Mar 1874).

He was married to Jane Stamps Brown on 5 Mar 1879 in Saline Co., MO. **Jane Stamps (Jennie) Brown** was born on 21 Apr 1850 in Independence, MO. She died on 18 Feb 1917 in Marshall Twp., Saline Co., MO, and was buried in Ridge Park Cemetery, Marshall, MO. She was previously married to William Breathitt Sappington Jr. on 25 Jun

1867 in Saline Co., MO. She was a seamstress and Matron at the Missouri Colony for Feeble Minded and Epileptic in Marshall, MO. Micajah Carr Sandidge and Jane Stamps Brown had the following children:

- 15 i. **Lenard (Leonard?) Sandidge** was born on 18 Dec 1879 and died on 19 Jun 1880, both in Marshall, Saline Co., MO.
- 16 ii. **Ida Celeste Sandidge** was born on 9 Mar 1881 in Marshall, Saline Co., MO. She died on 10 Apr 1913 in Kansas City, MO, and was buried in Elmwood Cemetery, Kansas City, MO. She was a designer in millinery. I think she never married, as she was single and still named Sandidge at the time of her death.
- +17 iii. **Louise M. Sandidge** (born on 19 May 1883).
- 18 iv. **Sara A. Sandidge** was born in Feb 1885 in MO. She died after 1922. She was a teacher at state institutions for the “feeble minded” in Missouri, Nebraska, and Kansas, and became Principal of the school at the Missouri Colony for Feeble Minded and Epileptic in Marshall, MO.
- 19 v. **Bessie M. (Genevieve) Sandidge** was born on 16 Oct 1891 in Marshall, Saline Co., MO. She died on 21 Mar 1917 in Kansas City, MO, and was buried in Ridge Park Cemetery, Marshall, MO. I think she never married, as she was single and still named Sandidge at the time of her death.

4. **Maria Louisa Sandidge** (John Wood-1) was born on 30 Sep 1841 in Saline Co., MO. She died on 20 Feb 1867 in Saline Co., MO, and was buried in Ridge Park Cemetery, Marshall, MO. She may have been known as Lou or Louise.

She was married to Mills Tandy Chastain on 11 May 1865 in Saline Co., MO. **Mills Tandy Chastain** (son of Willis Wilson Chastain and Mary Elizabeth Tandy) was born on 13 May 1839 in Logan Co., KY. Maria Louisa Sandidge and Mills Tandy Chastain were sixth cousins once removed, both being descended from Thomas Graves (about 1614 to about 1657). He died on 4 Aug 1928 in Marshall, Saline Co., MO, and was buried in Ridge Park Cemetery, Marshall, MO. He was a doctor and also was postmaster of Marshall, MO, for a time. He served in the military in the Civil War (Union). He had two other marriages after Maria’s death, to Fratie Holland in Oct 1870 and to Dora Cartwright in May 1905. Maria Louisa Sandidge and Mills Tandy Chastain had no children.

5. **Rebecca E. (Ella) Sandidge** (John Wood-1) was born in May 1844 in Saline Co., MO. She died on 28 Dec 1906 in Saline Co., MO.

She was married to James H. Craddock on 27 Feb 1866 in Saline Co., MO. **James H. Craddock** was born in Jul 1832 in Barren Co., KY. He died after 1910. He was a farmer. Rebecca E. Sandidge and James H. Craddock had the following children:

- 20 i. **Luella Craddock** was born about 1868 in MO. She died on 17 Dec 1891 in CO (this is not certain).
- 21 ii. **James Arch Craddock** was born in Jun 1869 in MO. He died in 1961. He was a farmer.
- 22 iii. **Robert McElroy Craddock** was born on 26 Apr 1873 in Saline Co., MO. He died on 3 Oct 1957 in Marshall, Saline Co., MO, and was buried in Mt. Olive Cemetery, Saline Co., MO. He was a farmer. He never married.
- 23 iv. **Mary E. Craddock** was born about 1875 in MO. She died before 1908 (based on not being considered for a share of her grandmother’s estate in Mar 1908).

6. **Presley S. Sandidge** (John Wood-1) was born about 1848, probably in Saline Co., MO. He died before May 1897 (based on not being mentioned in his mother’s will, which is dated 24 May 1897). He was a farmer.

He was married to Anna unknown. **Anna unknown** was born about 1860 in KY.

8. **Mary Wood (Mollie) Sandidge** (John Wood-1) was born on 12 Sep 1850 in Saline Co., MO. She died on 29 Jan 1929 in Denver, CO, and was buried in Fairmount Cemetery, Denver, CO.

She was married to Leonard Wilson on 6 Oct 1868 in Johnson Co., MO. **Leonard Wilson** (son of William Adair Wilson and Mary Elizabeth Reeves) was born on 13 Jan 1846 in Marshall, Saline Co., MO. He died on 22 Nov 1905 in Denver, CO, and was buried in Fairmount Cemetery, Denver, CO. He worked as a clerk for various companies and government organizations, and for a number of years he was postmaster of Marshall, MO. He was a soldier in the Missouri militia in the Civil War (on the Union side), and was taken prisoner by the other side. Mary Wood Sandidge and Leonard Wilson had the following children:

- 24        i. **William Wilson** was born on 22 Apr 1870 in Saline Co., MO. He died in infancy.
- +25       ii. **Leonie Wilson** (born on 3 May 1873).
- 26       iii. **? Wilson**. Died in infancy.
- +27       iv. **Horace Everett Wilson** (born on 1 Aug 1882).

### Third Generation

14. **Micajah Carr (Mike) Sandidge Jr.** (Micajah Carr-2, John Wood-1) was born on 27 Mar 1874 in Saline Co., MO. He died on 21 Mar 1945 and was buried in Ridge Park Cemetery, Marshall, MO. At different times, he was a salesman and a farmer.

He was married to Sadie T. Lee on 26 Nov 1907 in Saline Co., MO. **Sadie T. Lee** was born on 15 Nov 1873 in MO. She died on 1 Dec 1956 in Lindley Twp., Mercer Co., MO. She was a secretary.

17. **Louise M. Sandidge** (Micajah Carr-2, John Wood-1) was born on 19 May 1883 in Marshall, Saline Co., MO. She died on 11 May 1915 in Marshall Twp., Saline Co., MO, and was buried in Ridge Park Cemetery, Marshall, MO.

She was married to Charles Henry Champlin on 16 May 1905 in Denver, CO. **Charles Henry Champlin** was born on 12 Nov 1879 in Wayne, Steuben Co., NY (some records say 1880). He died before 9 Oct 1948 and was buried in Fairmount Cemetery, Denver, CO. Sometime before 1920, he remarried, to Selma Helen Beck. He was a carpenter and well driller. Louise M. Sandidge and Charles Henry Champlin had the following children:

- +28       i. **Celeste Therese Champlin** was born on 13 Feb 1906 in NY. She married Albert H. Winder about 3 Dec 1923 in Denver, CO. She married Anthony Bollers about 16 Dec 1931 in Arapahoe Co., CO. She married ? Vobora. She died on 24 Oct 1988 in Riverside Co., CA.
- 29       ii. **William A. Champlin** was born about 1908 in NY. He died before 2 Mar 1923 and was buried in Fairmount Cemetery, Denver, CO (it is not entirely certain that this is the correct death and burial info).

25. **Leonie Wilson** (Mary Wood Sandidge-2, John Wood-1) was born on 3 May 1873 in Marshall, Saline Co., MO. She died on 17 Jan 1973 in Denver, CO, and was entombed in Fairmount Mausoleum, Denver, CO.

She was married to Winslow L. Leighton on 4 Oct 1894 in Denver, CO. **Winslow L. Leighton** was born about 1868. He died on 27 Mar 1895, and was buried in Fairmount Cemetery, Denver, CO. He was a bank clerk.

She was married to John E. Rinker on 27 Jun 1900 in Denver, CO. **John E. Rinker** was born about 1869 in IA. He died in 1950, probably in Denver, CO. He was a lawyer. Leonie Wilson and John E. Rinker had the following children:

- +30       i. **Theodore Wilson Rinker** was born on 5 May 1901, probably in Denver, CO. He married Loretto Dorothy Paul about 1929. He died in Apr 1977, probably in Denver, CO. He was a partner of an armored-car company, Armored Motors Service.
- +31       ii. **Mary Catherine Rinker** was born on 4 Jan 1911, probably in Denver, CO. She married George T. McGrew between 1953 and 1959. She died on 16 Dec 1987, probably in Denver,

CO, and was entombed in Fairmount Mausoleum, Denver, CO. She was a bookkeeper and a bank clerk.

27. **Horace Everett Wilson** (Mary Wood Sandidge-2, John Wood-1) was born on 1 Aug 1882 in Marshall, Saline Co., MO. He died on 11 May 1943 in Riverside, CA, and was buried in Olivewood Cemetery, Riverside, CA. He was an electrician. He was known as Everett or Harry.

He was married to Rose Lino on 17 Apr 1903 in Golden, Jefferson Co., CO.; they were divorced on 4 Jan 1907 in Denver, CO. **Rose Lino** (daughter of Dominick Lino and Therese Berry) was born on 18 Mar 1883 in Denver, CO. After the divorce with Horace, she had several other marriages: to Elijah J. Sickler between 1907 and 1910 (divorced 18 Nov 1910 in Weld Co., CO); to Edward W. Cookingham on 20 Nov 1919 in Trinidad, Las Animas Co., CO; to Charles W. Nash in Sep 1927; and to C. J. Nicholson before 1959. She had no children from those later marriages. She died on 3 Oct 1965 in Denver, CO, and was buried in Mount Olivet Cemetery, near Denver, CO. Horace Everett Wilson and Rose Lino had the following child:

- +32 i. **Leonard Everett Wilson** was born on 4 May 1904 in Denver, CO. He married Elizabeth Marie Trinaistich (daughter of Mate Trinajstić and Elizabeta Dukić) on 20 Oct 1926 in Trinidad, Las Animas Co., CO. He died on 17 Sep 1981 in Albuquerque, NM, and was buried in Gate of Heaven Cemetery, Albuquerque, NM. He was a radio-station operator and electronic-parts wholesaler.

He was married to Jennie Marie Nyman on 23 Sep 1909 in Coeur D'Alene, Kootenai Co., ID. **Jennie Marie Nyman** (daughter of Nels Nyman and ? Sigler) was born on 18 Nov 1885 in Stockholm, Sweden. She immigrated to the U.S. in 1896 and was naturalized in 1907. She died on 4 Mar 1960 in Arlington, Riverside Co., CA, and was buried in Olivewood Cemetery, Riverside, CA. Horace Everett Wilson and Jennie Marie Nyman had the following children:

- +33 i. **Leonie Eileen Wilson** was born on 29 Mar 1916 in Chewelah, Stevens Co., WA. She married George Bagley (not completely certain about his last name) before about 1936 and divorced him about 1937. She married Lloyd George Trickey about 1937 and divorced him on 20 Mar 1987 in Tarrant Co., TX. She died on 9 Oct 1998 in Lancaster, CA, and was buried in Olivewood Cemetery, Riverside, CA.
- +34 ii. **Nyman Adair Wilson** was born on 21 Nov 1918 in Seattle, WA. He married Carmen Andrea Navarro about 1942. He died on 5 Nov 1999. He served in the U.S. Navy in World War II and the U.S. Army in the Korean War.
- +35 iii. **Clarence Robert Wilson** was born on 19 Apr 1922 in Santa Monica, CA. He married Berta Adaline Laurance on 20 Jul 1941 in Yuma, Yuma Co., AZ (not completely certain about the name of his wife and the marriage info). He married Sue T. unknown. He died on 6 Feb 2007.
- +36 iv. **Harry Everett Wilson Jr.** was born on 19 Apr 1922 in Santa Monica, CA. He married Theone M. Raub. He died on 24 Oct 2006 in Riverside, CA, and was buried in Riverside National Cemetery, Riverside, CA. He served in the U.S. Army Air Force in World War II.
